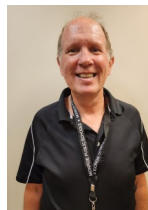

## From the Director's Desk

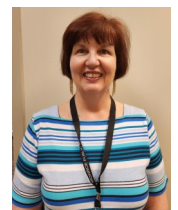
### Welcome to the Team!
